MOTHER THATIPATHRI GNANAMMA (1819-1874)



THE PATRON OF THE SCHOOL

SAINT THATIPATHRI GNANAMMA (1819-1874)

The Congregation of Sisters of St. Anne-Madras was founded by a lay woman namely Thatipathri Gnanamma. She was born in 1822 at Pirangipuram in Guntur District in the State of Andhra Pradesh, India, as the second child of Gali Rayanna and Mariamma. A pious devout couple. Gnanamma was deeply prayerful and grew to become a pure, Humble and simple young girl embedded with the virtues of charity, piety, generosity, sacrifice and hard work, the rich values practiced by her parents. In 1837, young Gnanamma was given in marriage to Innaiah, then catechist of Phirangipuram. The pious couple Innaiah and Gnanamma had five sons and curiously they had no daughters, for providence had reserved thousands of girls to be adopted by Gnanamma in the later days.

Widowhood came as a storm in her life at the age of 37. Freed at last from all family Commitments, Gnanamma moved to a village called Kilacheri, 40 kms from Chennai and settled down there. Thus, the infinite wisdom of God led her step to Kilacheri the cradle, the very Bethlehem of the new Congregation.

During her time, the education of young girls was an impossible dream. Fr. Arokianathar, the parish priest of Kilacheri, helped her to reflect concretely and starting a school at Kilacheri for girls. In 1862, she sold all her properties to meet the expenses for starting a school at Kilacheri. She started a school exclusively for girls in 1863.

In 1871, the two young women, requested Gnanamma to let them help in her work and expressed their desire to do so as nuns. Fr. Arokianathar trained them under the Sisters of Congregation of Good Shepherd at St. Anne's Novitiate, Bellary. The Specific vision for the betterment of women known as "Society of the Sisters of St. Anne – Madras" was born. This was the seed that was sown for the two future religious congregations for women initiated by Gnanamma.

Gnanamma was suffering from asthma, feeling that her end was drawing near, she called all her spiritual daughters and gave them her last instructions. She received the last sacraments from the hands of Fr. Rathna Nathar and went to her eternal reward on 21st December 1874 in the age of 52. She is the Foundress of two Congregations, namely, St. Anne's of Madras and St. Anne's Phirangipuram.

On September 21, 2013 Rev Dr. Goerge Antonysamy raised her as Saint; on January 21, 2014 the Holy See declared Thatipathri Gnanamma Innaiah as servant of God. Let us continue to pray for this special intention.

HISTORY OF THE CONGREGATION

The origin of our Congregation is tracked back to 19th Century in the state of Tamil Nadu, India. It was founded by **Thatipathri Gnanamma**, a lay woman from Phirangipuram, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh.

Our Congregation was raised to the Pontifical status on 6th December 1979 by Pope John Paul II. The Generalate is located in Madawaram – Chennai. In 1987, Our Congregation was divided into three administrative regional units with separate head quarters in Bangalore, Chennai and Tanjore.

Today, there a number of challenges that perpetuate sadly the marginalization of certain Segments the population. We, the followers of Gnanamma, address these issues through Various specific services”.

As our predecessors were true to the vision of our Foundress by opening schools in Remote Villages to educate the girls. We have opened health centres, homes for Children, Widows, the handicapped and the aged as well as social work centres in remote villages and tribal areas to work for the liberation. We cross borders create new boundaries and take up any mission that serves the poorest of the poor.

The journey which Gnanamma took in 1874 with two young professed sisters, has reached the state where we are today. We March on with great vigour reaching out to the people who are on the periphery. We are confident that the strong vibrations of our Foundress will continue to illuminate, guide, protect, preserve, increase and strengthen us in our journey of religious life and committed missions towards a just and equal society. At present, the numerical strength of our Congregation is 617 with 134 houses in 43 Dioceses.

Beatified, Blessed Thatipathiri Gnanamma’s Feast Day is celebrated as **St. Anne’s Feast Day** in 26th July.

RULES & POLICY

1. ADMISSION POLICY

The School admits students to classes from Play class to class 11. Students shall be admitted irrespective of their cultural background, ethnicity, gender, disability or infirmity and religious affiliation.

Fees once paid will not be refunded. A student once admitted cannot be withdrawn without 1 month of notice or 1 month fee in lieu of the notice.

2. ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

THE RULES REGARDING ATTENDANCE ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Parents should see that their wards are not absent except under unavoidable circumstances as it badly hampers the progress of the pupil.
2. The reporting time to school is 8.20 to 8.25 AM. The student should be in the school premises before 8.25 AM.
3. Arriving to school on time is part of learning a sense of responsibility.
4. Senior school students are expected to be on the school campus at 8.00 AM.
5. The last period of the day is just as important as the first. Leaving school early without permission is strictly prohibited. Students are not permitted to leave the school campus for any reason after arriving at school unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

6. The School timings:

Class Primer-A To Grade-9	8.30 AM To 4.15 PM

3. WITHDRAWAL POLICY

1. When a child is admitted in the middle of the year, Registration (Admission) fee and all the other Fees for the remaining terms, have to be paid.
2. If a student is withdrawn from the school in the middle of the year all fees due to the school till the end of the term have to be paid.
3. If a student is to be withdrawn from the school at the end of the academic year, notification for such Withdrawal must be made in writing to the principal before 15th of April. If applied after this date, Term I fees for the next year have to be paid.
4. TC shall be issued only after clearing all the existing fee dues.

GENERAL

1. Parents are responsible of sending the ward to school in time
2. A parent wishing to meet the ward in the school should seek prior permission from the Principal.
3. Every parent is requested to see that his ward wears the uniform prescribed by the school.
4. Absence during day test / examination will be viewed as a serious matter. No re-test will be conducted.
5. Students found copying or indulging in any other malpractice during tests and examination shall be subjected to severe disciplinary action.
6. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school in supervising their children's study at home and help them to improve in the subjects marked weak in the report card.
7. Parents are expected to go through the reports of their wards given by the school from time to time.
8. Parents should examine the Diary daily and sign the remarks made by the teachers or the Principal. Parents should make sure that the lessons and homework are done.

9. Parents are requested not to send any remarks or comments about the management or teachers in writing through the students. They may kindly come in person and express the same to the principal.
10. When a call letter regarding a student's work or conduct at school or outside goes to the parents they must respond to it in right earnest in the interest of their child.
11. Parent should attend open day without fail both for Mid Term Test and Term End Examinations.
12. Parents are requested to check the school's S.M.S & Co-Operate according to the message sent.

NOTE:

1. Full year's Tuition fees should be paid before June 15th
2. No pupil will be allowed to sit for the Examination if fees are in arrears.
3. Fees once paid is non refundable.

RULES OF MAINTAINING THE SCHOOL PROPERTIES:

- Educomp and Eduwrite boards are very expensive. Please do not play with them.
- Children should not tamper with the projectors switch boards or the electrical gadgets.
- Switches, fans, cupboards in the classrooms should not be handled by students.
- The wiring circling the educomp boards should not be touched.
- The Educomp and Eduwrite projectors are meant for teaching. Student should not operate or touch in the absence of teachers.
- Children should not scribble or damage the benches in the classroom.
- Rest room utensils and taps should not be broken by the students.
- Lab apparatus should be handled with care and if any damage caused fine will be collected from the concern.
- Children are advised not to touch the CC cameras.
- If all or any above are violated, parents will be called and disciplinary action will be taken against the student.

- Non –formal dresses are not allowed inside the school campus except on birthday.
- Costly, fancy and colourful ornaments should not be wore by the students.

ACADEMIC WORK AND ASSIGNMENTS

- Homework will be assigned on a regular basis.
- Students should note down all their assignments given on a particular day in his/her school diary. It is mandatory that every student brings his/her school diary to the school every day.
- All assignments will be meaningful with the aim to provide reinforcement and enrichment to the students.
- All assignments and homeworks must be submitted punctually.
- Students are free to approach their subject teachers for academic help whenever they are free within school hours.
- Principal / headmistress will receive parents 3.00 p.m to 4.00 p.m. all meeting must be on prior appointment.
- Parents are requested to check their ward's diary and sign everyday. If needed information can be sent through the diary.
- When children return from school everyday. Please check if there is any homeworks / assignments given or if there is any communication of circular to the parents from the school.
- Our school provides all textbooks and notebooks for all classes. During the last week of April you will get to know the list of books and notebooks that would be supplied to your child and the amount due for them.
- A separate note book shall be used for communicating homeworks / assignments.

MISCELLANEOUS POINTS

- Every student is expected to maintain a standard of manners and etiquette. In particular, they should.
- Greet teachers, administrative staff, visitors and of course each other.
- Never keep hands in pocket while talking to other, especially to staff and elders’
- Show consideration for the need of other.
- Observe queue wherever required.
- Never cast an embarrassing glance at people who are differently abled, tease or make sharp remarks to hurt others.
- Do not cut in when two others are talking.
- Take pride in their personal appearance and use words phrases like Thank you, Please, Excuse me appropriately.

TWENTY COURTESY POINTS

INTRODUCTION

We are judged by strangers, based on, our behavior, politeness and good manners. They make a favourable impression, about us if we behave badly in public we not only let ourselves down, but also our parents, our teachers and our school. By trying to control ourselves in speech and actions we shall build up a good standard of behaviour. In time if we persevere, our efforts will become habits so that we maintain them always. Then we can truly say that we are well – mannered. The following “Courtesy points” will help us in our effort.

1. All the Students in class should stand when a visitor enters the room. They should remain standing unless or until told to sit. They should stand again when the visitor leaves
2. Students, wishing to enter the class room, when the teacher is in the room, should wait outside the door for permission to enter.
3. Always stand smartly in attention when spoken to by a teacher or by elders. Donot lunge with hands in the pockets etc.
4. Treat old people with respect and help them whenever they are in need.
5. It would be courteous to say, 'may I help you' to any stranger in the school building, who obviously does not know the way round or needs some help.
6. Always stand aside, and let the elders have the way.
7. If a teacher or any adult anything, politely pick it up and give it to the person.
8. If you are seated in a crowded bus and an old person gets in and finds no vacant seat, stand up politely and offer yours.
9. Students should greet with respect teachers and adults known to them either with both hands(Namasthe) or with the right hand(salute).
10. When greeting people it is better to say 'Good morning', 'Good afternoon', etc., than 'Hello'.
11. If you have to pass close in front of any one always say 'Excuse me'
12. When speaking to visitors in school, address a lady as 'Madam' and a gentleman as 'Sir'.
13. Chewing (gum, sweets, etc.,) in public is not polite and is forbidden in the class-room.
14. Cultivate the habit of quietness, controlled movement an speech.
15. If you do not properly what was said to you, say, ' I beg your pardon'.
16. Say, 'Thank you' for any service rendered to you.
17. Do not talk in the library; consultations, if any, should be in whisper.
18. In the class or in hall when the teacher or a speaker is talking to the class or to the Assembly, keep silent.
19. If you MUST cough or sneeze in public, do it quietly into a hand kerchief, but refrain from doing it, if possible.
20. **Final Note** : The proof of genuine good manners is the constant practice of allthe courtesy points in a natural, effortless and unobtrusive way.
